

# Protest Workers

Number of workers in each category depends on the size of your city/event.

Numbers below are for our KC event, expecting 1,000-10,000 people.

- **Administrative workers** (5) – takes care of flyers, planning, permits, talking with police, etc.
- **Church Liaison** (1) – contact and work with local churches to get them involved
- **Day of Helpers** (4)– emcee, stage manager, greeters, cleaners (everyone helps!), etc.
- **Evangelists** (10) – have short (3 min) messages prepared for speaking at the event, man a table to help people get saved
- **Financial** (1) – help create a budget, assist with purchases, works closing with administrative workers
- **Legal** (1) – contact a Christian attorney in the off chance someone may need his counsel.
- **Media** (2) – handles advertising, taking pictures, social media, news media liaison
- **Messaging** (1) – person who figures out what God is saying for your city and promoting that before and during the events, works closely with the evangelists
- **Police Liaison** (1) – contact with the police department
- **Prayer Team** (20+) – to cover the event, the people working, those coming and praying for salvations and for change to come to the city
- **Security** (20) – works closely with administrative workers and helps set the perimeter of the event
- **Set-up/Tear Down** (10) – crew with trucks, dollies, garbage cans and liners, gloves. Responsible for table and chair setup for registration and will work closely with sound and tech people.
- **Sound** (2) – Determine size of sound system needed, locate and operate it.
- **Technology** (1) – Website creation

\*Many workers filled several roles. Our team was made of 6 workers until the event when we add all the others.
